PARIS Status Codes	PARIS Reason Codes
<p>Status codes are used to determine the status of a waste diversion program selected by a jurisdiction for an individual year. Status codes also indicate whether a waste diversion program was listed as selected in a jurisdiction's Source Reduction Recycling Elements (SRRE) planning documents. Use status codes to indicate whether a program was implemented, dropped after being implemented, not implemented, planned for the future or whether an alternative program was implemented.</p> <p>SI: Selected and Implemented. The program was selected by a jurisdiction in its planning documents, and has been implemented in the reporting year.</p> <p>SO: Selected and Ongoing. The program was selected by a jurisdiction in its planning documents, was implemented in a prior year and is currently ongoing.</p> <p>AI: Alternative and Implemented. The program was not selected in the SRRE, but has just been implemented during the current reporting year.</p> <p>AO: Alternative and Ongoing. The program was not selected in the SRRE, but was implemented prior to the current reporting year.</p> <p>PF: Planned in the Future. The program is planned for implementation by a jurisdiction in the future.</p> <p>D: Dropped after Being implemented. The program was dropped after it had been implemented by a jurisdiction.</p> <p>DE: Dropped in an Earlier year. The program was dropped in an earlier year.</p> <p>NI: Selected and Not Implemented. The program was selected in a jurisdiction's planning document but not implemented.</p> <p>NA: Not Selected or Planned. Used only when program was implemented in a later year.</p>	<p>Reason codes explain why a program was dropped after being implemented, or was not implemented by a jurisdiction. Note: Not all jurisdictions that have dropped or not implemented a program have, or are required to give, a reason code.</p> <p>1 = Delays in bringing diversion facilities online</p> <p>2 = Unavoidable regulatory delays</p> <p>3 = Existing contractual or legal problems</p> <p>4 = Insufficient funding</p> <p>5 = Insufficient staffing</p> <p>6 = Lack of cooperation from other entities</p> <p>7 = Sufficient diversion without selected program</p> <p>8 = Lack of markets necessary to support program</p> <p>99 = Other</p>
