Glossary

Glossary

California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB): The state agency which oversees waste management for California.

Cooperative Regional Project: The short term used to describe the "Rural Cooperative Recycling Infrastructure Development Program" (RCRIDP) of the CIWMB.

Cooperative Regional Plan: The short term used to describe the "Regional Purchasing, Processing and Market Development Plan for Del Norte and Humboldt Counties" presented in this document.

Environmental Services Joint Powers Authority (ESJPA): A joint powers agreement to which 20 California counties belong, including Del Norte County.

Humboldt Recycling Market Development Zone (RMDZ): An existing RMDZ for Humboldt County established in 1992

North Coast RMDZ: A proposed RMDZ for Del Norte and Humboldt Counties, application process begun.

RecycleStore.com Website: An internet website sponsored by the CIWMB to assist the marketing of recycle-content products. Over thirty recycled-content products manufactured in the Del Norte - Humboldt Region have individual product web pages on the site. These manufacturers and products were identified as part of the Cooperative Regional Product and web pages developed for them.

Voids Analysis: A Service Voids Analysis is a process for prioritizing future implementation of recovery programs, correlating each type of material being disposed within a region with a potential new or expanded recovery program or with targeted actions towards extended producer responsibility. This term was coined by Dan Knapp of Urban Ore to describe the process of correlating the quantities of materials being disposed to the existing and potential programs that could recover each material type.
